



COVID-19 Catch Up Pupil Premium

Following unprecedented disruption in Education caused by the Covid-19 Pandemic, those young people from the most vulnerable and disadvantage backgrounds have been most hit. The lost time in education will have a substantial impact and the responses must match the scale of the challenges faced.

Special, Alternative Provisions and Hospital schools have been allocated £240 per place for the 2021/22 academic year.

To date Endeavour Academy has received £8,000 which was allocated to interventions and supporting mental health and wellbeing.
