Within Endeavour, staff ensure that Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural (SMSC) learning cuts across the entire academy.

This helps us to develop a deeper knowledge and understanding of the wider world by learning about the beliefs, cultures, difficulties and needs of other people.

In turn, this helps both staff and students, to develop greater consideration, care and empathy for the world around us.

To support our SMSC curriculum work we are in the process of creating wall displays which will ask students to ponder a variety of questions designed to make them really think about the SMSC issues that affect their everyday lives. We ask that staff, students and even visitors to the Academy are mindful of those around them and are respectful of their beliefs. A restorative approach is used to reiterate the importance of mutual respect and treating all others in the way in which we hope to be treated ourselves.

The academy staff plan to hold special events which will promote and further embed our SMSC message throughout the academic year. These include a Community Cohesion SMSC day, a whole school SMSC day and gender specific SMSC events.
