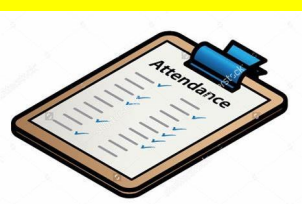
Students can purchase additional items at a cost listed on the price list shared via School Ping last half term.
