

Alongside our Core Curriculum of English, Maths and Science, each student participates in various activities and planned intervention sessions which aim to identify areas in need of development. We build upon, recognise and reward 'The Eight Essential Skills' which research tells us employers look for. In school, our staff facilitate whole school, small group and 1:1 sessions which help strengthen each skill. A process which is tracked regularly and encourages students to self-assess and articulate their journey.

In science we have been learning about electricity. Students enjoyed wiring plugs and learning about the different components and safety features.






Also In science we have been studying the immune system.


Students developed their understanding of how our bodies protect us from infection (and origami skills!) by making paper antibodies to demonstrate how antibody shape is important in the immune response.
